# Model RC-4 Remote Control

### **GENERAL DESCRIPTION**

The Model RC-4 Remote Control is specially designed for Marantz 4-channel audio components. The Model RC-4 incorporates a 4-channel balance control to adjust the relative outputs of all four channels, a volume control to adjust all four channels simultaneously, and a loudness switch to compensate for the human ear's response to bass and treble frequencies at low volume levels.

#### CONNECTION AND OPERATION

- 1. Be sure the power switch of the master unit is OFF.
- 2. Connect the plug of the RC-4 to the rear panel **REMOTE CONTROL** jack of the master unit.
- Put the remote control switch of the master unit into the REMOTE position.
- 4. Put the RC-4 volume control in the MAX position.
- Put the volume control of the master unit in the MIN position.
- 6. Center the RC-4 balance control.
- 7. Put the power switch of the master unit ON.
- 8. Increase the **volume** control of the master unit to the loudest level at which you will be listening.
- The volume may now be adjusted with the RC-4 volume control.
- Place the RC-4 control unit near your usual listening position.
- 11. Adjust the **balance** control for the most pleasant 4-channel balance.
- 12. When listening at low volume levels, put the RC-4 loudness switch ON. This will boost bass and treble tones to compensate for the human ear's insensitivity to these frequencies at low volume levels.

NOTE: Because the volume control of the master unit is operative in the REMOTE mode (see 4-8, above), the maximum volume achievable with the RC-4 volume control is limited by the master unit's

volume control. If you have the RC-4 volume control in MAX position and wish to further increase the volume, simply increase the setting of master unit's volume control.

#### CAUTION

- Always turn the master unit's volume control to its minimum position before changing the position of the master unit's remote control switch. Failure to do so may result in damage to your loudspeakers.
- 2 Since the Model RC-4 is designed only for Marantz 4-channel units, no provisions are made for application to audio sets made by other companies. Any attempt to use the RC-4 with other sets may result in serious damage for which Marantz is not liable.
